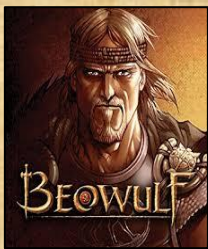




Year 5: Autumn Term 2026

As mathematicians, we will explore Place Value including partitioning. We will be working on the operations of addition and subtraction, using all our strategies.

As historians, we will be investigating the impact that the Anglo Saxons had upon life in England from their arrival and the legacy of this time period.



As computer programmers, we will learn how to create quizzes using the 2Quiz programme on Purple Mash. We use a variety of quiz type questions and design and make our own fun quiz!

As scientists, we will investigate the properties of materials including the changes we experience when materials change state.

As language learners, we will be studying how to use French to describe ourselves. We will hopefully become more language confident in our speaking

As athletes, we will be developing our football skills of sending and receiving, and obviously team skills. We will also begin our swimming lessons.



As writers, we will begin the year looking at poetry and writing poems about ourselves. We will then study Beowulf and focus on character description and publish our own quest myths.

As readers, we will investigate texts about life as Anglo-Saxons as well as reading myths and legends from across the world.

In PSHCE, we will be studying Me and My Relationships and how these change as we get older.

As religious scholars, we will be looking at Creation and Covenant - how God created the world and why it is now our job to be 'stewards' of this creation. Our work will focus on God as Creator and the sacred, binding promises made between God and humanity throughout history

In Design Technology, we are going to design and manufacture an Anglo-Saxon slipper reinforcing our sewing skills with a range of stitches



As artists, we will be using a range of media to explore the Anglo-Saxons including working with pen and line drawing and cardboard collage.

As musicians, we will listen to and learn to play 'Livin on a Prayer' by Bon Jovi on a glock. We will explore a variety of rock songs and have fun with rhythm and pitch games.
